ISSUE 2 What is it?

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- Every ten (10) years, Ohio conducts a census of its population. Based upon the outcome of the census, the boundaries for our Senate, House of Representatives and Congressional seats are redesigned to fit the population.
- Ohio's Constitution allows elected representatives to design the new boundaries.

OUTCOME

- Typically, the **political party holding power** designs and redistricts these legislative seats to favor their party and/or specific candidates.
- History has shown that this occurs whether the Republicans hold power or the Democrats hold power.

WHAT ISSUE 2 DOES:

- Creates a 12-member independent citizens commission that would redesign the legislative lines after each census.
- The commission would be made up of independent citizens - not politicians, not elected representatives.
- Four (4) Republicans, four (4) Democrats, and four (4) non-affiliated voters will serve on the commission.

The final redesign/redistricting would require a

 majority vote by seven (7) of the commission members.

Our political system is broken.
